WHAT IS A CUTTING HORSE?

A horse that is trained to separate a single cow out from a herd of cattle, by first reading the intentions of the rider on which cow to sort away from the herd. Then reading the single cows' body language and intentions, the rider turns over control to the cutting horse to respond with lighting fast reflexes to go fast, stop hard and make big sweeping turns to mirror the cows movements in its attempt to return to the herd.
